School times are:
8:50am – 1.20pm or 2:20pm for **surnames A - K**
9:00am – 1.30pm or 2.30pm for **surnames L - Z**

Pupils will use designated doors only and go directly to classrooms.



Pupils are encouraged to walk or cycle to school.



To pick up a child during school hours, please phone first.
Parents must use the intercom at the front door on arrival.



There will be no access to the school for parents or visitors, bar exceptional circumstances.



All staff will complete COVID induction training.



We will use outdoor learning spaces when possible. Pupils should bring a coat to school



As per current guidelines, all staff will wear a mask where 2M distancing is not possible.



Pupils and staff will wash their hands regularly, using proper technique.



Everyone will use the hand sanitiser provided on entry and exit to the school.



The class will be cleaned daily. Toys will be disinfected weekly.



Pupils must be kept home with **high temperature, cough, breathing difficulties or loss of taste or smell**. Pupils should also be kept home if generally unwell.



Pupils should stay home for 14 days after returning from travel abroad.



If showing symptoms, the pupil will be isolated and parents called. Parents will contact GP.



Each class is one bubble.



Each bubble will be divided into pods. Children will be seated apart at a pod. Some mixing of pods will happen at the junior end of the school.



All pupils should have an individual box of stationery and supplies which can be kept in school.



Any shared resources will be wiped down at the end of the day.
